

Articles for consignment will be accepted at the discretion of the marking committee. The condition of your merchandise is the key for salability. Therefore, we accept only those garments that are in season, in style, dry-cleaned or freshly laundered. Clothing that is out of style, worn, wrinkled or soiled, as well as clothing with broken zippers, missing buttons or belts, cannot be consigned and may be discarded. We also ask that bric-a-brac be complete, clean and polished.

Only merchandise that meets our standards of style and cleanliness will be accepted for consignment. Articles are priced by the marking committee in line with the Shop's policy. Minimum price of consignment for clothing and bric-a-brac is \$1.00. Consignors MUST call the shop (845-358-7488) on the day they want to bring articles into the shop and are asked to come in NO MORE THAN TWICE EACH MONTH. Twelve (12) articles of clothing on hangers or one (1) bag or box of bric-a-brac will be accepted, as space permits.

Consignments are kept sixty (60) days and become the property of Grace's Thrift Shop after this period, if not reclaimed by the pick-up date. The marking committee issues the pick-up date when the consignment is put on sale. The pick-up date (expiration date) on all holiday items will be 10 days after that holiday.

NO MORE THAN

Checks are issued quarterly in January, April, July and October and will be mailed together with a list of the merchandise sold during that quarter. No checks will be issued for less than \$10.00.

The Shop is NOT responsible for loss due to fire, theft or damage of any kind. Items are left at the consignor's risk.
